Homestay Courses with 20 lessons

Listening, speaking and reading within a playful, creative context form the core of the tuition that is much practice-oriented. Tuition always takes place in the mornings. Courses are supplemented by afternoon excursions that are carefully prepared and evaluated in class by our teaching staff.

Activity programs and excursions

All cities offer a wide variety of leisure-time activities, sports and sightseeing. Courses include 4 activities (Berlin: 5) per week and one full-day excursion to regional sights every Saturday. Please note that the respective excursion which takes place on the day of departure (Saturday) will not be included in the price.

Accommodation

Participants stay with selected host families which live primarily in the outskirts of the city. Schools can be reached by public transportation on average within 20-30 minutes and at a maximum travel time of one hour. Generally students share a double room. A single room can be booked at an extra charge.

Aschaffenburg | 12 to 16 years

The 1,000-year old city of Aschaffenburg lies in convenient distance to Frankfurt airport and is bordered on the east by the Spessart mountains, one of Central Europe's largest continuous forested regions. The city itself with its historical monuments like the monumental renaissance castle Johannsburg abounds with parks and green spaces as well as it offers a wide variety of cultural life. All around the year Aschaffenburg presents a colorful range of fun-filled festivals – but especially during the summer city life is extremely exciting here.

Berlin | 14 to 17 years

Berlin attracts people from all over the world. There's essentially no other city in Europe undergoing such a powerful transformation as is the capital city of Germany. Berlin is hip, young, international and creative. Families, students, and hipsters alike give it a unique and colorful flavor. With more than 3.5 million inhabitants, Berlin is the largest city in Germany. Like pieces of a mosaic, each district, with its individual character, adds to an exciting overall look and feel. In addition to its city attractions, Berlin is surrounded by a large number of parks and lakes.

Cologne (Köln) | 14 to 17 years

Germany's oldest city, towered over by the spires of its world-famous cathedral offers many cultural and historical treasures from Roman and medieval times, world-famous museums and an active art scene. Modern Cologne, though, has a leading position in media production. Life in the city is uncomplicated and vivacious with many pubs, cafés and restaurants. Located at the river Rhine, Cologne is surrounded by mountains and idyllic valleys with castles, monasteries and choir ruins. And even the well-known *Loreley* is just round the corner.

Nuremberg (Nürnberg) | 14 to 17 years

Nuremberg is Bavaria's second largest city. Its heart lies within the 14th century defensive wall with a total of 80 towers. Much of the center is pedestrian precinct. Timbered houses of the Middle Ages still stand intact in narrow streets and on open squares among shops, cafes and eating places. The dominating feature is the *Kaiserburg*, the old imperial castle. Worldwide known are the *Nürnberger Lebkuchen* – gingerbread that can be found in different shapes and sizes all over the city. And of course, even the little sausages have made the city's name famous.

Wiesbaden | 14 to 17 years

When picking the right place to learn the German language one might not think about Wiesbaden right away. That is because the first words visitors encounter after arriving in Wiesbaden are French or English including *Faites vos jeux*, *Roulette*, *Black Jack* or *Poker*. That's right: Wiesbaden is the *Monte Carlo* of Germany. The town is rich and beautiful, and its Casino is world-famous. But with its 270,000 inhabitants, Wiesbaden is also a city with a high leisure-time and living value for younger people.
